

Marine Animal Research Questions

It's time to plunge into the ocean and learn about your marine life! Remember to stay in character and research your animal. Use the websites provided in the WebQuest to discover and explore your marine life. Then, in your notebook, answer the following questions.

- 1. Give a physical description of your marine life. Find out information about physical characteristics. It is helpful to know about any physical features that are different between males and females of your species. Other physical characteristics may include:
 - Body coverings (scales, shells, skin, fur)
 - Size (in some species there is a large difference in size between males and females)
 - · Other physical adaptations of interest
- 2. Description of the area where you live (your habitat in the ocean)
 - climate
 - environment
 - location
 - shelter/housing
- 3. Description of diet. What kind of things does your marine life eat?
- 4. Describe everyday activities that your marine life carries out. (*For example, swimming, hunting for food, escaping from prey, impressing human tourists*)
